1 POLICY & PRACTICE

- A review of mental health & psychosocial (MHPSS) services for refugees in transit was completed and published.

FUTURE DIRECTIONS

- Designing guidelines for the provision of MHPSS services for refugees in the transit context.
- Designing recommendations for providing continuity of care for people on the move.

2 RESEARCH

- A study on the impact of the transit context on MHPSS services has been published.
- A regional study on mental health and wellbeing of refugees has been started.

FUTURE DIRECTIONS

- Completing and publishing the regional study on refugees' mental health.
- Conducting a study on suitability and acceptability of mental health screening of refugees.

3 ADVOCACY & NETWORKING

- CoReMH website is published.
- 2 new members joined the network.

FUTURE DIRECTIONS

- Broadening our network & delivering advocacy initiatives for improving the rights of people on the move.

4 CAPACITY BUILDING

- Two trainings for CoReMH members were delivered on:

 - (2) Providing MHPSS services to Ukrainian refugees
